Green Spaces

Cardiff is a green city with plenty of **parks and recreational areas** in and around the city centre.

Bute Park in the **city centre**, behind Cardiff Castle, offers you extensive parkland with plenty to do.

Roath Park is a 45 minute walk from Ty Admiral and includes a **large lake with boats** for hire, children's play area, tennis courts, rugby pitches, basketball, a library and cafe.

Further afield you can reach the **Brecon Beacons National Park** (1 hour by car) and **several beaches.**

Barry Island is just outside Cardiff and has a **funfair, boardwalk** and **sandy beach** and is reachable by train from the city centre in 40 minutes.
